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Course descriptions and Information

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Art Adventures Grades K-3 at Farragut Room 6 – Learn to draw, paint and create your own art.

Adventures in Literature Grade 1 at Farragut Room 9 - Explored literature, writing, art, games and music.

Amazing World of Fish and Reptiles Grade K-3 at Farragut Room 8 – This exciting class explores the amazing world of reptiles, fish, frogs, and other animals. Students will learn from our live animals, writing, art, reading, and film.

Basketball Camp Grades 2-8 at CCMS Basketball Gym - Learn and improve your game. Play on teams and compete in free throw, hot shot, and lay up contests as well as Friday team tournaments. Boys and girls of all skill levels are welcome.

Beginning Piano and Music Grades 4-8 at CCMS Room 001 - This class teaches beginning piano as well as how to read music and music appreciation. Keyboard pianos are provided during class.

Beginning Guitar and Music Grades 4-8 at CCMS Room 001 - This class teaches basic guitar as well as how to read music and music appreciation. Students must bring their own guitar.

Beyond the Book Report Grades 4-8 at CCMS Room 130 - readers can learn many ways to respond to what they read. We will work on new ways to express our thoughts, questions, and feelings about what we read.

Ceramics Grades 4-8 at CCHS Room 3 - We will learn several ceramic techniques and create many projects, like bowls, animal figurines, masks, fake food and more. Students will also freely explore working on their own projects.

Cooking is Fun! Grades 4-8 at CCMS Room 210 - Students will learn and perform the preparation and cooking of a variety of foods. Students will also learn about nutrition, and the class will include a variety of games and more.

Japanese Immersion ♦ K at Farragut Room 1 ♦ Grades 1-2 at Farragut Room 12 – K class is an introduction for children entering Kindergarten. K-1 students should already know Hiragana & enough vocabulary to communicate in the classroom.

Math Review Grade 4-6 & Grade 7-9 at CCAS Room 7 – These classes are designed to review the math skills that students should know for their coming school year. If you need extra help in math, or you want to get ahead, this is the class for you.

Musical Theater Grades 3rd-12th at CCHS Robert Frost Auditorium – Students will prepare and rehearse for 5 weeks in preparation for a matinee and evening performance. Every student will get a part. Evening dress rehearsals will take place from 3:30 to 6:30 the last week of class and the performances will be July 30th at 7:00 PM

Photography and Photoshop Grades 4-8 at CCMS Room 110 - Students will learn photography, the fundamentals of Adobe Photoshop and Photoshop Elements, and create their own portfolio by creating, manipulating, and combining digital images. Students must bring their own digital camera (some are available for less than \$40 at stores such as Target and Best Buy.)

Spanish Immersion ♦ Grade K at Farragut Room 2 ♦ Grade 1-2 at Farragut Room 11 - Learn Spanish as we play games, spin tales, perform plays & do art projects while speaking in Spanish.

Science is Fun Grades 6 – 8 at CCMS Room 421 - Explore how fun science can be through experiments and labs. Our labs will include germination, DNA, flower dissection, frog dissection, worm dissection, fruit, and more.

Team Sports ♦ Grade 1-3 at Farragut Athletic Field ♦ Grade 4-8 at CCMS Blacktop - Kids will learn the rules and basic fundamentals of all sorts of different team sports. Enjoy the fun and improve your skills and sportsmanship.

Young Authors Grade 2-3 at Farragut room 5 – Students will read literature and create their own stories. During the 5 weeks, they will create a bound book filled with a collection of their stories and illustrations.

Young Writer's Workshop Grades 4-6 at CCMS Room 130 - Students will hone both their writing and critical thinking skills via a variety of fun and creative writing assignments. Students will compile a portfolio of their work by the end of the session.

Wonderful World of Literature Grade 2 at Farragut Room 10 - Explore literature through a variety of fun activities. Students will work on improving their reading and writing skills by reading stories, doing writing assignments, art projects & games.
